About the Centre for Advanced Studies in Botany

The University Botany Laboratory (UBL) was established in 1930 and it acquired the CAS status from the UGC in 1964 and retaining the status for more than 50 consecutive years. The CAS in Botany is well known for its pioneering research contribution on Plant Pathology, Mycology, Algology and Herbal Science. Eminent Professors like M.O.P. Iyengar, T.S. Sadasivan, C.V. Subramanian, A. Mahadevan, J. Lalithakumari, N. Anand, R. Rengasamy and N. Raaman have served as past Directors of this Centre. Presently, Prof. N. Mathivanan is the Director of the centre. CAS in Botany is fully equipped with all necessary laboratory facilities and other infrastructure.

About the Conference

The field of 'Algology' has been recognized as one of the thrust areas of research by the University Grants Commission (UGC) at the Centre for Advanced Studies in Botany in 1964 and the status is being maintained even today. The National Conference on Biodiversity, Biology and Biotechnology of Algae provides a platform for direct interaction for attending delegates, with scientific and technical leaders in this field. Emphasis will be given on the latest unpublished technical and scientific results, along with discussion and interactions with strategic partners and leaders in the field. The conference will cover all areas of emerging technologies in the broad field of algal research, including micro and macroalgal: biology, biomass production, cultivation, harvesting, extraction, biorefinery, feedstock conversion into fuels, bioproducts, and econometrics and etc. Hence, it has been planned to bring together all senior Algologists, Professors, Scientists and active Researchers from various Universities, National Institutes, and Research students together with the members of all the Phycological groups and Societies from across the nation to deliberate the future focus of algal teaching, research and technology development in our country.

Prof. M.O.P. Iyengar Algologist Award

Prof. M.O.P. Iyengar Algologist Award will be presented to algologists under the age of 35 as on 15.11.2016** who will be selected as the best oral presenter by a selection committee during the conference. Each participant will be given 20 minutes for presentation and five minutes for discussion. The award will carry a certificate and cash prize of Rs. 3000.

Prof. T.V. Desikachary Memorial Award

Prof. T.V. Desikachary Memorial Award will be presented to Research Scholars/Students under the age of 35 who will be selected as the best poster presenters by a selection committee during the conference. This Memorial Award will carry a certificate and cash prize of Rs. 2000.
