The eligibility criteria for the aforementioned course are as follows:

Candidates who have successfully completed an Undergraduate/Postgraduate degree in the any Science stream from the University of Madras, or an equivalent program recognized by the University of Madras or any other recognized University, / B.Tech Engineering/ Environmental Engineering/ Civil Engineering/ B.Tech Geoinformatics/ Remote Sensing/ Bachelor of Applied Science/ are eligible for admission.

Duration : 1 Year Program ; Total Credits : 18

Assessment : 6 Courses, 100 Marks Each

Total Hours: 120 Hours of Lectures + Mandatory Field & Practical work
