TERMS AND CONDITIONS*

The following Endowments were founded by the University of Madras in view of the Centenary celebration of the Aringnar Anna, Former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, and it was accepted by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 15-07-09.

1. Thiruvalluvar Endowment Scholarship.
2. Periyar Endowment Scholarship
3. Aringnar Anna Endowment Scholarship.
4. Dr.Kalaigarnar M.Karunanidhi Endowment Scholarship.

The following terms and conditions are proposed for the award of above scholarship.

1. The Scholarship shall be effective from the year 2009-10 onwards.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to the students of the Departments of the University of Madras.
3. The Scholarship shall be awarded to register Ph.D scholars only.
4. The Scholarship shall be awarded to the students who secure highest mark in the qualifying PG degree and should have passed all the papers in the first attempt. A rank list will be prepared from the applications received and selection will be made accordingly.
5. Applications shall be called for once in a year in the month of April, to fill any vacancy that arises in the event of student leaving / completing programme.
6. The value of Scholarship is Rs.8,000/- p.m. (as per Syndicate dated 18.12.2015) and the tenure of the scholarship is for three years (renewable each year) or till he / she submits the thesis, whichever is earlier.
7. The award of scholarship will be decided with a fair distribution among all subjects by a Committee constituted for this purpose.
8. The Scholarship shall be automatically terminated at the expiry of the prescribed period irrespective of the date of submission of thesis.
9. Students who are not availing any fellowships / scholarship from any other source alone are eligible to apply.
10. Thiruvalluvar Endowment Scholarship shall be awarded to the students of Languages (including foreign languages). Periyar Endowment Scholarship and Aringnar Anna Endowment Scholarship shall be awarded to the students of Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities. Dr.Kalaigarnar M.Karunanidhi Endowment Scholarship shall be awarded to the students of Sciences.
11. If the number of applications in a particular category is less than the total number of scholarships, then the vacancy will be filled with students from other category. For example, vacancy in the Thiruvalluvar Endowment Scholarship will be filled with students from Social Sciences and Humanities or with students from Science and vice versa. This is applicable only for that particular period (3 years) and is proposed for the effective implementation of the scholarships to the needy students.
12. No department should be given more than one scholarship at any point of time.
13. Unspent balance if any shall be added to the Corpus fund.
14. The Scholarship can be terminated by the University at any point of time without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
