Regulations

Submission of the Thesis

12(a) Not later than six months after the submission of the synopsis and after the expiry of the minimum period of research prescribed, every candidate shall submit along with the prescribed application and fee for the Ph.D , Degree, Five Copies of Thesis, embodying the results of the research carried out by him/her of which one copy of the Thesis shall be deposited in the Department Library of the Institution when he/she conducts research for consultation by anyone in the Department or from outside.

14(d) The candidate, whose thesis has been approved, shall submit himself/herself of a public viva-voce examination by the supervisor-Convener and one external examiner in India appointed by the University. Member of the department in the subject concerned where the candidate conducted research and outside Specialists if any in the field may participate in the Public viva-voce Examination. The Supervisor-Convener shall convey to the University the result of the Public Viva-Voce Examination duly endorsed by the External Examiner. The candidate who is successful at the Public Viva-Voce Examination shall be declared to have qualified for the Ph.D. degree.
