Ph.D. Regulations (No.10.5). A candidate whose thesis has been recommended for the award of the degree by the Board of Examiners should submit the thesis to a public viva-voce examination conducted by the supervisor and one external examiner appointed by the syndicate in the department/institution where the research work was conducted. The Indian examiner, who valued the thesis, shall, as far as possible, be appointed as external examiner to conduct the public viva-voce examination of the candidate.
