**Ph. D. REGULATIONS**

12(a): Not later than six months after the submission of the synopsis and after the expiry of the period of research prescribed, every candidate shall submit with his/her application for the Ph.D. degree five copies of the thesis, embodying the results of the research work carried out by him/her of which one copy of the thesis shall be placed in the Department Library of the Institution where he/she conducted research.

14(d): The candidate whose thesis has been approved shall submit himself/herself to a Public Viva-Voce examination by the Supervisor and one External Examiner appointed by the University. Members of the Department in the subject concerned where the candidate conducted research and outside specialist, if any, may participate in the Public Viva-Voce. The supervisor shall convey to the University the results of such Public Viva-Voce examination duly endorsed by the external Examiner. A candidate who is successful at the Public Viva-Voce examination shall be declared to have qualified for the Ph.D. degree.
