INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Note : Instructions to be detached and retained by the candidates for Guidance

1. Applications for admissions to this Examination together with the Demand Draft must be forwarded to reach the Controller of Examinations *not later than the third week of February*.
2. Late applications will be accepted after the date specified on Payment of Penalty fee of Rs. 100/- upto days only (i.e., 1st March).
3. It will not be possible for the Office to reply to enquiries regarding the receipt of application in the office till they are sorted out and arranged and replies to such enquiries will be delayed, even though full particulars are furnished. Candidates are, therefore, advised to send their applications by Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due, so that they may have a ready means of knowing that their applications have reached this Office.
4. The Prescribed fee* should be sent by a Demand Draft drawn in any of the State Bank of India or Nationalised Banks or Scheduled Banks in favour of THE REGISTRAR, UNIVERSITY OF MADRAS, CHENNAI - 600 005, payable at Madras, giving full particulars regarding the name of the examination and nature of fee in the covering letter enclosing the draft, without which, the remittance is liable to be refused.

5. The fee one paid will not be refunded or held over for a subsequent Examination under any circumstances.
6. Candidate must write the name and that of father or guardian in full, and if an *Indian*, in *Regional* language (in Tamil) as well as in English. If a change in the name has been recognised by the University, the name under which the Candidate had already been enrolled in the University records should also be given.
7. Candidates must be careful in entering their age. Those who can give the exact date of their birth, should enter the day of the month on which and the year in which they were born as well as their actual age on the date of application. Those who are unable to give this information, must enter the number of years and the number of Calendar months they completed on the date of application.
8. Candidates are requested to give an address as complete and accurate as possible, as would ensure any communication by post reaching them without delay both interm and in vacation.
9. Candidates must forward with the application the Diploma or qualifying certificate of having passed the Examinations in this University or of having taken a Diploma in some other University accepted by the Syndicate as equivalent thereto. These will be returned to the Principal of the College concerned for transmission to the Candidates in due course.
10. The Examination will be held only at CHENNAI AND MADURANTAKAM. Candidates must obtain their Hall Tickets, etc., from the Chief Superintendent of the Centre at which they are to be examined during the three days before the commencement of the examination.
11. Candidates will be permitted to appear for the Examination only at centres they are known or can be identified and the place of examination first given cannot, be changed after registration at any circumstances.
12. All candidates appearing through PRIVATE STUDY should submit with their applications, two clear recent copies of photograph in the size 6cm x 8cm. The actual size (Excluding the margins) of the photos furnished should be 5cm x 5cm showing the Chest of the candidate. Each copy of the photo print should have a margin of 1.5 cm at the top and 2.5 cm width at the bottom. The signature of candidate must be affixed along the margin at the top and that of the certifying Officer should be along the margin at the bottom. (Front portion of the photos).

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

One copy of the photograph should be pasted in the space marked in the application form and the other to be securely fastened to the application in such a manner that it should be easily detached from the application.

The candidate should sign his/her full signature along the top margin of each of the photo copies on the front portion. The signature on the photo copies should confirm in every detail to the Signature at the bottom of the application.

Applications received without photos duly signed as per rules will not be registered.

Each copy of the candidate's Photograph should be attested by the following persons only. (Gazetted Officers - Central or State; Principals of College affiliated to this University; Principals of Oriental Title Colleges; Principals of Matriculation Schools; Headmasters or Headmistress of Government recognised High School in the State, Military Commissioned Officers, Members of the Syndicate, the Senate, the Academic Council and Board of Studies of the University of Madras.)

The Officer who has signed the Photographs should also certify in the space provided for this purpose in the application form to his personal knowledge of the Candidate.
